### Parade Participants

#### Parade Route

Please follow the attachment of this year's parade route. Please keep the parade moving at a slow and steady pace, with no gaps in between parade units.

#### Children

Parent/guardians are responsible for the safety of their children. Please, children under age 6 should not walk the parade route. They have trouble keeping up with the vehicle in front of them. Be mindful of the length of the route and weather conditions. Children participating in the parade must be always under the supervision and direction of a responsible adult.

#### Cancellations

If you must cancel, please let us know ASAP. Failure to notify us of a cancellation on your part may put you on the waiting list for the next parade. Please note that the City of Port Washington reserves the right to cancel the event at any time, for any reason. In this unfortunate event, You will be notified by email or phone and a refund will be issued.

#### Weather Policy

Fish DayS is a rain or shine event, unless inclement weather rolls in. Every effort will be made to put on the parade including delay in starting the parade due to severe weather. The event will not be rescheduled.
